These figures represent the average manpower response counted on apparatus that responded to an incident during all operational periods of an incident. The data is organized by incident series type, which is described in the top rows of the table. There is potential for a slight difference in the total number of total firefighters who responded as this method does not record firefighters who responded only to the fire house or arrived after the completion of operations. These figures do provide the closest available numbers for an annual average of how many firefighters the Honeoye Falls Fire Department is able to utilize in order to affect the outcome of these types of incidents.
