→ The following resolution was offered by Justice
Levermore and moved its adoption

Whereas a notice that the Town Board of Mendon
would hold a public hearing for the purpose of
considering the establishment of a fire protection
district within the Town of Mendon, containing a
description of the proposed fire protection district
and specifying the time when and the place where
the Town Board would meet to consider the
proposition and to hear all persons interested
in the subject, has been published and posted

as required by law; and a public hearing has taken place at the Mendon Center School House in the Town of Mendon, Monroe County, New York, within the limits of the proposed fire protection district, on the 5th day of September 1939.

And Whereas - said meeting was adjourned to Sept 18 1939, at the same time & place, and personal notice of said adjournment and the time and place thereof was given to every landowner within the limits of the proposed district; and the adjourned meeting has taken place.

It is hereby resolved - that this Board find and determine upon the evidence given at such hearing; that it is in the public interest to establish the said fire protection district;

And it is further Resolved - that, pursuant to Section 171 of the Fire Law, State of New York; there be and hereby is established a fire protection district within the Town of Mendon, to be contained in and under the following boundaries to wit;

— Beginning at a point on the westerly line of the Town of Mendon where the said line meets the southerly line of Monroe County; thence northerly along the said westerly line of the Town of Mendon to the northerly line of the Town of Mendon thence easterly along said Mendon town line to the Pittsford - Mendon Center Road so called thence southerly along the Pittsford - Mendon Center Road, excluding all property fronting on either side of said road which is included in the Mendon Fire District #1, to Mendon Center thence southeasterly along the Bull Saw Mill Road excluding all property fronting

on either side of said road, as above to the Chamberlain Road; thence southerly along the Chamberlain Road excluding all property fronting on either side of said road, as above, to the Taylor Road; thence easterly along the Taylor Road excluding all property fronting on both sides of said road, as above, to the West-Blomfield-Pittsford Road then southerly along the West-Blomfield-Pittsford Road excluding all property fronting on either side of said road, as above, to the southerly line of Monroe County, thence westerly along said County line to the east line of the Village of Honeoye Falls; thence northerly along said Honeoye Falls line to the north side line of the Village of Honeoye Falls, thence westerly along said north Village line to the west line of the Village of Honeoye Falls; thence southerly along said west Village line to the southerly line of Monroe County; thence westerly along said County line to the place of beginning; intending hereby to describe a district bounded on the west and north by the Mendon Fire Line, on the east by the westerly line of Mendon Fire Dist^{#1}, and on the south by the southerly line of Monroe County and the Village of Honeoye Falls.

Motion adopted.

The following motion was presented by Justice Livermore and seconded by Justice Martini.

Motion made that the Public Hearing to be held to consider the approval of the said contract for Fire Protection in the Fire Protection District.

1939 at 8 P.M., and that the notice of such
meeting be published according to law.
