

This table and graph represent the average manpower response to Emergency Medical Incidents (EMS) from 2015-2022. The data is represented in terms of total available manpower, which is the number of operational members in the fire department that year. The average manpower that responded on apparatus to these incidents and the estimated number of Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) that responded. The estimated EMT number is calculated by taking the total number of EMTs on the roster that year, dividing that by the total available manpower and applying that percentage to the average manpower that responded.
