Margaret Fiore, 383 Pond Rd, reported her concern to extend the moratorium, especially when there is a short-term rental being illegally operated on Mile Square Rd. She was really hoping for a decision soon.

COMMUNICATIONS

HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT, Andrew Caschetta, reported the spray park parking lot is finished, catch basins are cleaned out, Christmas trees have been picked up, and patching was done. He reported the State has not paid the 2021-2022 payments, which is holding him up. The lane certification miles were recorded wrong, so the SALT money will be help up, and he proposed a logo for the Code Enforcement Officer's truck.

TOWN CLERK, **Michelle Booth**, reported on tax collection; the Town should be paid in full by Friday. She also stated there is a new Mendon Youth Center tab available on the Town of Mendon website; she will continue to update.

TOWN BOARD

Brent Rosiek, reported on the upcoming Planning Board meeting; discussions in regards to the Spray Park septic; and the Mendon Community Business Association's list of events in 2023. Mr. Rosiek says the owner of the Mendon Wok building is considering something other than an apartment, that might fit into the Code. 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





Dear Supervisor Moffitt:

LaBella Associates, D.P.C. is pleased to submit the following proposal to the Town of Mendon - Town Board to provide design services for new sidewalks within the Hamlet area of Mendon. The following proposal outlines our understanding of the project, scope of services, proposed fee, and anticipated schedule.

A. PROJECT UNDERSTANDING

We understand that the Town of Mendon would like to expand the sidewalk network within the Hamlet of Mendon, including new sidewalks along the following road segments:

- Route 64: Assembly Drive to Pittsford Federal Credit Union
- Route 64: Route 251 to Taylor Road
- Route 251: Route 64 to Mile Square Road
- Mile Square Road: Lehigh Valley Trail to Taylor Road
- Taylor Road: Route 64 to Route 251

The purpose of this project is to prepare a concept design-level plan of the proposed new sidewalk network along with supporting documentation and construction cost estimates for the Town of Mendon to use in pursuit of grant funding. Future project phases could include detailed design and construction of individual sidewalk segments.

B. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Preliminary Investigation & Field Work

State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR), Permitting, and Regulatory Compliance

An environmental review of the proposed concepts will be completed in order to evaluate initial requirements of SEQR, as well as other environmental regulations. Based upon an initial review of the proposed action, LaBella believes that the proposed project can be classified under SEQR as an "Unlisted Action."

Anticipated tasks include:

- a. Completion of SEQR short forms, Parts 1, 2 & 3.
- b. Provide a Town Board Resolution documenting SEQR Determination of Significance.
- c. Cursory screenings of State and Federal wetlands, threatened / endangered species, and cultural resources using available online tools.



Survey

An instrument survey will be performed to obtain existing surface feature and topographic information necessary to complete the conceptual sidewalk design. Survey will include the roadway segments identified in Section A above, to include a width of right-of-way plus 10 ft, along each side of the road. Tasks anticipated during this phase to complete a topographic and limited boundary survey for the project include:

- a. Coordination with Dig Safe New York for mark-out of existing utilities.
- Location of all existing site features including roadways, driveways, parking areas, trees, and swales.
- c. Location of existing surface utilities, including storm sewers, manholes, catch basins, hydrants, curb boxes, utility poles, etc. within the right of way.

Engineering Site Visit

Engineering staff will visit the site for a visual assessment of existing features, grades, obstructions, and suitability of one side of the road versus the other for proposed sidewalks. The site visit will also include review of potential environmental concerns.

Concept Design

Concept Plan

Concept design-level plans will be developed for the sidewalk segments identified in Section A. The plans will depict design elements such as alignment, typical section, potential right-of-way / easements required, location of potential retaining walls, utility relocations, drainage improvements, and road / driveway crossings.

Plans will be developed in Microstation format at an appropriate scale.

Engineer's Report

An engineer's report will be prepared to accompany the preliminary sidewalk plans. The report will include a written description of sidewalk design and engineering considerations. The report will also include a summary of environmental screenings.

Cost Estimates

Preliminary-level construction cost estimates will be developed for each of the proposed sidewalk segments using the New York State Department of Transportation Preliminary Estimating Tool. The estimates will include all anticipated construction items as well as contingency. Costs will also be provided for design plans and evaluations meeting applicable funding source requirements.

C. ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Should the Town of Mendon wish to proceed with detailed design and construction of new sidewalks. LaBella Associates is available to perform additional services upon agreement of scope and fee, including:

- a. Final Design of sidewalk segment(s)
- b. Preparation of permit applications (NYSDOT)
- c. Preparation of funding / grant applications
- d. Assistance with bidding and construction contract award

Dear Mary:

In response to a complaint made on Dec. 8, 2023, regarding possible light trespass to your home on the parcel indicated above, I was able to perform an inspection of an exterior lighting fixture located on the attached garage of 22 Rolling Plains East. At the time of inspection, I observed the following conditions:

On Feb. 1, 2023, at 7:10 pm, I drove down Rolling Plains East, passing the residence of Mr. Anthony Saporito (22 Rolling Plains East) at which time a motion sensing twin head flood lamp was activated. The light fixture was aimed down the driveway to the North, and stayed on for approximately 1-2 minutes, then turned off. After turning the vehicle around on Old French Road, I again drove past the residence at which time the flood light activated again. I attempted to measure the lighting intensity from the road right of way in front of 22 Rolling Plains, with an exposure meter, however the light intensity was not great enough to register on the meter. Subsequently I recalibrated the meter and attempted several other readings from adjacent locations and was unable to record any greater than 0.1 footcandles in front of the home. Finding no clear violations of light trespass according to the town lighting ordinance, a significant amount of glare was noted. At 7:18pm I concluded the testing and exited the neighborhood.

In good faith, I will send the property owners at 22 Rolling plains a letter explaining the Town's lighting regulations outlined in chapter 260 Article XIII., and request that they submit details demonstrating that the lighting fixture meets these requirements. I will also inform the resident that lighting in residential zones shall not be visible above ground level at the adjoining public roadway pavement edge or 25 feet beyond the property line or at an adjacent dwelling unit.




