Climate Smart Communities

Registered Climate Smart Community - Local governments are designated as Registered CSCs after passing the CSC pledge as a formal resolution.

Bronze Certified Climate Smart Community - The initial level of certification; local governments that have acted their commitment to climate action and taken steps to implement climate-smart policies and projects.

Silver Certified Climate Smart Community - The second level of certification; local governments that have implemented a range of foundational climate actions and made concrete progress toward goals.

Gold Certified Climate Smart Community - The third level of certification; currently under development by New York State.

Why Bronze Certification Matters

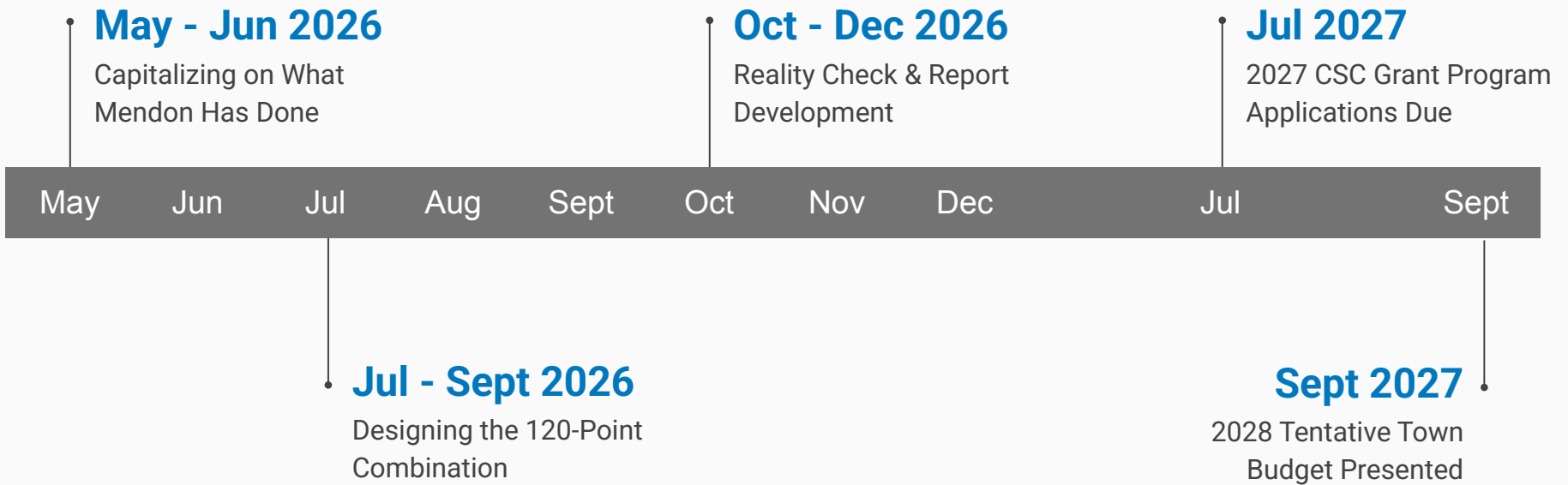
- **Priority for Funding:** Mendon receives higher point scores on applications for the DEC CSC Grant Program, which offers 50/50 matching grants of up to \$2 million for municipal projects.
- **Wider Grant Eligibility:** Certified status boosts the town's scores for other NYS infrastructure programs and NYSERDA Clean Energy Communities funding.
- **Streamlined Roadmaps:** Access to free technical assistance, templates, and regional CSC Coordinators to organize future town projects efficiently.
- **State-Level Recognition:** Mendon is publicly recognized by the New York State DEC as a leader in municipal sustainability, making the town more attractive to new families and green businesses.
